Defects in woven piece-goods (cellulosic and cellulosic blends)

1 Scope

This part of SANS 10076 is applicable to woven cellulosic and cellulosic blended fabrics. It covers the permissible number of defects, stringing of defects, length deductions for defects, net length and colour matching and includes a reference to various defects that may occur in woven cellulosic and cellulosic blended fabrics.

It is not applicable to pile or terry fabrics.
